The spex event is an event where all teams perform a spex they created. Here, FU will act as judges and will follow specific criterion for assigning points. It will be preformed at vita scenen in Stadsparken.

Preparation and Execution

You in your teams will come up with your very own spex to perform to win favour of FU. This will require you to work as a team to come up with a story, create props and perform your spex live in front of FU, your mentors and other novisches. You have from the Intro day till the date of the spex 12th of September to prepare and practice. You get to choose the plot of the spex, however trying to keep with the theme of this years Novisch period, A Party Paradox. Try to include as many people as possible in your performance.

Rules

FU loves organized chaos so here are some rules to keep in mind:

- This is a team event so please only use actors pulled from your own team.
- The spex must include at least **one** song that you have rewritten the lyrics to (otherwise it would not be a spex!). It can be an original song as well!
- Limit of the spex is 20 minutes.
- Remember we are trying to keep the spex enjoyable for everyone so please perform in English.
- Turn up on time to the event and be organized and ready to perform when it is your turn.
- At the event please be respectful of everyone's spex as everyone has worked hard, so try to keep quiet during the performance, except for laughter and thunderous applause.

The judges (FU) will give points 1-10 in each of the categories listed below. These points will then be added together and the team with highest points win! As in the big events 250, 150, 100, 50 points are given and added to the score.

- Spex-yness How much song, dance and jokes are included?
- Props How much effort is put into the props and accessories of the spex?
- Story How coherent is the story? How intrigued does it make the judges?
- Cheesyness How much cheese is included? Is it gouda, chevré or maybe roquefort? Is the story so cheesy it makes the judges turn in their seats? Note that two members of this years FU are vegan, so choose your cheese wisely.
